1. Colour the four layers as stated below:


Ocean – blue	Middle mantle – pink	Upper mantle – yellow
Oceanic crust – black	Lower mantle - purple	Inner core - red
Continental crust – brown	Outer core – orange	

- 2. Cut out each of the layers carefully.
- 3. Take two pieces of white paper. Place one piece of paper on top of the other so that a quarter of the bottom page can be seen. Fold the two pieces together so that there are four equal visible flaps. Staple the sheets of paper at the top of the foldable.
- 4. Paste each part of the layers in the correct order on each section of the foldable.
- 5. Cut out the provided labels and identify where each label is represented on the foldable.
- 6. For each section of the foldable, answer the following questions...
 - a. Composition (rock/minerals it's made of)
 - b. Thickness
 - c. State of Matter (Solid? Liquid? Both?)
 - d. Temperature (range or average)
- 7. Additional research to be done for each of the layers of the Earth... (Be sure to write your responses in your foldable)
 - a. Crust:
 - i. Compare and contrast the properties of Oceanic Crust and Continental Crust. Discuss **at least** 2 similarities and 2 differences.
 - b. Mantle:
 - i. How is each sub-layer of the mantle (upper, middle, lower) different?
 - c. Outer Core:
 - i. Why is it a liquid?
 - d. Inner Core:
 - i. Why is it a solid?
 - ii. How is the core related to the Earth's magnetic field?
